Track One

A one year, full time program that maximizes mentorship and learning through daily interaction between the Fellow and the Fellowship Faculty. Provides over 250 hours one on one hours in addition to over 65 didactic hours in dynamic group settings.

Track Two

A one to three year program that allows the fellow to continue current employment while participating in weekly or monthly training to accomplish the Fellowship learning goals. Designed to meet the minimum APTA credentialing requirements and exceed these requirements on an individual basis.

Track Three

An individually designed program which allows the Fellow to travel to various Fellowship sites and spend a variable amount of time at each site to complete the requirements and gain exposure to a wide variety of training approaches.
